

## PhD Programme in Complex Systems for Quantitative Biomedicine (former Complex Systems for Life Sciences)

**Special project: grants for Students** 

January 2021

The Faculty has decided to dedicate part of the residual funds of the past years to finance particular activities of the Students, respecting the grant types allowed by these funds. Admissible projects are as follows:

- 1. missions and leaves of first-year students who do not have the 10% budget;
- 2. periods of research and study abroad of more than two months, in those cases where the Student 10% research budget and the extension of the scholarship provided by UniTo are not sufficient (this situation must be proven);
- 3. participation in qualifying courses abroad, where the cost cannot be tackled with the 10% research budget;
- 4. organization in house of courses on specific topics not covered by courses or initiatives of the doctorate or UniTo (the request must be made by at least four students).

To obtain funding, Students must respond to four-monthly calls, indicating in detail the subject, the reasons for the request, the period of time and the estimate of costs, and attach a brief letter of support from the Tutor. The requests will be examined by a subcommittee of the Faculty and funded, according to the adequacy of the project and the availability of funds.

**1st deadline**: 28th February 2021 (requests examined 1st week of March)

**2nd deadline**: June 30, 2021 (requests examined 1st week of July)

**3rd deadline**: October 31st 2021 (requests examined 1st week of November)
